

## Tradition 2: Take Away Questions

1. Do I trust in the group conscience ( and group officers) knowing that God is acting through the collective conscience of the group, and that therefore the group conscience is trustworthy?
2. If/when the group conscience doesn't go the way I think it should do, I abide by it willingly? Or do I complain and gossip and threaten to "quit"
3. Am I willing/able to listen respectfully to minority opinions (especially if they are different from mine) or am I inflexible and argumentative?
4. Do I need constant credit/praise or thanks for my service work? Or do I do it with a servant's heart regardless of credit, praise or thanks?
5. Although I have been sober for awhile...am I still willing to do the more mundane jobs like setting up the room, making the coffee or sweeping up? Or do I secretly believe I am above these tasks?
6. In group discussions, do I sound off about things I have no experience and little knowledge? Or am I able to defer to those with more knowledge and experience?
