4. Do I let someone's background, financial status, religion, race, age or education affect my willingness to welcome a new person providing they are alcoholic?
5. Do I follow the guidelines laid out in "Problems Other Than Alcohol" regarding membership? Do I suggest to non-alcoholics that they are/can be members of AA?
6. Do I insist on conformity within my group? Or am I able to "live and let live"?
7. Do I try to help non-alcoholics in a loving and supportive way to find the help they need? Even if that is in another fellowship?
